Recommendation: Implement a EMS Captain Stipend
Discussion: The scope of the EMS responsibilities has increased. Therefore, staff recommends implementing a stipend for the workload and critical program oversight associated with this assignment. The District is the only Advanced Life Support Volunteer Agency in Sacramento



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County. The stipend of \$6,000 yearly will be funded by removing one of the three Battalion Chief positions, so the stipend will not fiscally impact the budget.
